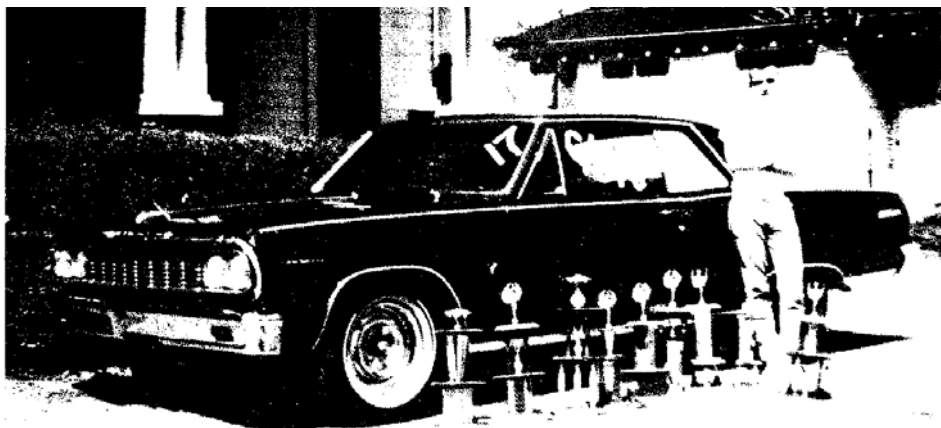


Larry's 1957 Chevy that he owned when we got married in 1963.
