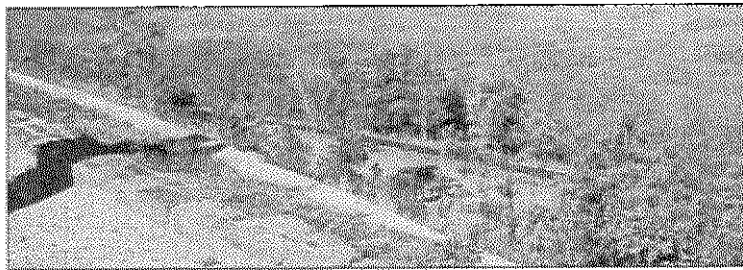

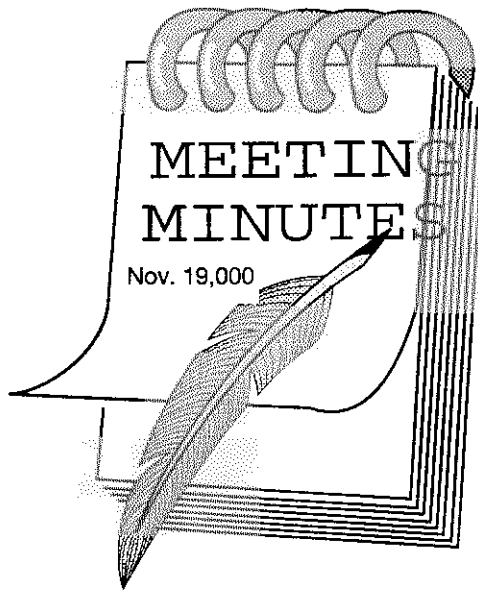
The November 19, 2000 meeting was held at A & W in Oklahoma City and began at 2:05 p.m.

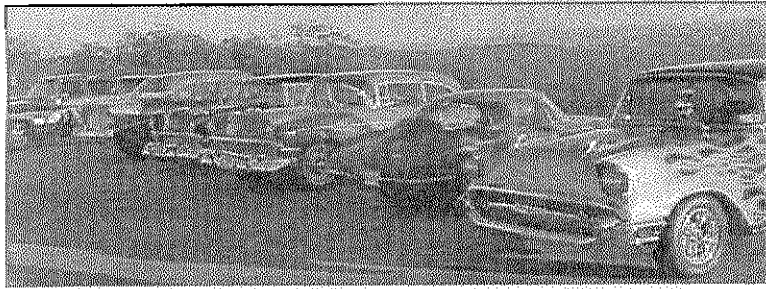
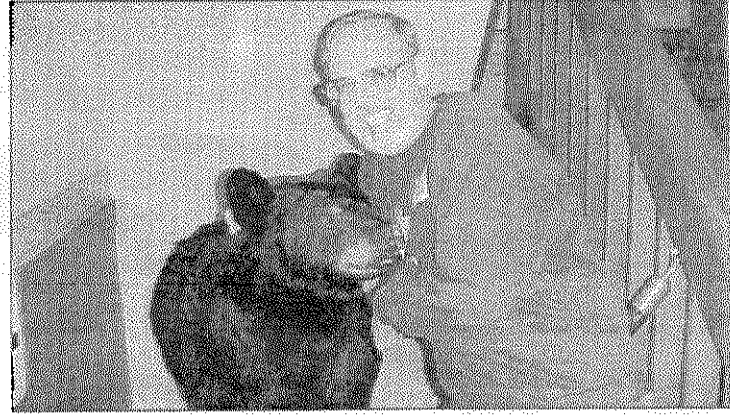
